## 1. Governance Updates

At the January 10 meeting, the Jeffco Board of Education unanimously approved JA's Charter Replication Application for the Coal Creek Canyon Campus (JA-CCC). The approval came with a condition that JA must reserve \$250,000 for JA-CCC in case of budget constraints. Additionally, in order to be eligible for the CCSP Replication Grant to help fund the school, the Colorado Department of Education required an amendment to JA's enrollment policy, capping the number of staff and founding members' students to 20%. The JA Board approved the funding condition and enrollment policy changes at the January 23 meeting and provided direction to Tim Matlick, JA Executive Director, to move forward in hiring a transition lead with the goal of opening the campus for the 2024-2025 school year. Jeffco also required more information regarding how MTSS will be handled in the new school, which the administration will provide.

On January 18th, Jeffco Board of Education approved JA's Charter renewal without any question or raising any concerns. The JA BOD would like to express our gratitude to Tim Matlick, school administrators, and JA staff for their hard work on the charter renewal application!

#### 2. Academic Successes

JA Secondary was recently recognized by the Jeffco School Board for achieving an impressive graduation rate of 98%, making it one of the top-performing schools in the district. Moreover, our elementary school has witnessed remarkable progress this year, with 66% of students who initially had academic challenges surpassing expectations and demonstrating significant academic improvement. Kudos to our teachers and students for reaching these impressive achievements!

### 3. Community Cares

We are extremely grateful to everyone who contributed to our JA Community Cares Holiday program this year. Thanks to your generosity and support, JA distributed 41 holiday care packages worth a total of \$38,000 in donations. This accomplishment is truly remarkable and a testament to the strength of our community. A special thanks to Tiffany Blakley, Community Engagement Coordinator, who spent countless hours making sure this program is a success and our JA families have wonderful holiday memories.
