Finance Committee

- Finance committee met on Jan.18th, and reviewed current operational budgets from each school. Expenses are on track for mid-year, and clean-up of line items and streamlining utility payments is in process.
- Administration is considering improving the process of delivering teacher offer letters so that teachers have a clearer picture of their compensation for the coming year approximately a month earlier than in previous years. Finance committee is involved because offers relate to state revenue projections and therefore impacts budget forecasting.
- To approve the replication application regarding Coal Creek Canyon, the District placed a couple of conditions that require financial and staffing consideration and ultimately JA Board approval.
- Finally, in line with the revised budget, Secondary, Elementary, and Summit have begun utilizing funds for outside professional evaluation of proposed facilities improvements to better understand scope of work and feasibility.
