





HOW SATISFIED ARE YOU WITH THE STUDENT REGISTRATION PROCESS?





DID YOU ATTEND PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES?




WHAT WAS YOUR OVERALL SATISFACTION WITH PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES?








DOES YOUR CHILD(REN) FEEL SAFE AT JEFFERSON ACADEMY ELEMENTARY?






HAS YOUR CHILD EXPERIENCED ANY UNSAFE SITUATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS?



HOW SATISFIED ARE YOU THAT YOUR STUDENT'S ACADEMIC NEEDS ARE BEING MET?




TO WHAT EXTENT DO YOU FEEL INFORMED WITH REGARD TO SCHOOL NEWS AND INFORMATION?




WHAT ARE THE PRIMARY METHODS BY WHICH YOU LEARN ABOUT SCHOOL EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES?


WHAT PREVENTS FAMILIES FROM COMPLETING THE REQUIRED 20 VOLUNTEER HOURS




RECOMMEND:




Do you feel your student(s) have academic gaps that are lingering as a result of the pandemic disruption?


Do you have the support you need to address the academic gaps of your student(s)?








Do you feel your student(s) has (have) social/emotional needs as a result of the pandemic disruption?

ONGOING THEMES

- Many responses were positive and showed great Appreciation for the teachers
- THE LARGEST GROUP OF COMMENTS MENTIONED A NEED FOR IMPROVED COMMUNICATION
- ALIGNMENT OF SCHOOL CALENDARS AND LATE START
- HOMEWORK
- INDIVIDUAL LEARNING NEEDS ARE NOT BEING MET
- LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES
- SOME COMMENTS EXPRESSED THE NEED FOR MORE CLUBS, ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES, AND EXTENDED JAG CARE
- DRIVE LINE CONCERNS AND SAFETY AT THE SCHOOL

FEEDBACK IMPACTING STRATEGIC GOALS

COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNICATIONS

- Many families are concerned over the lack of communication between parents, teachers and the administration
- There is frustration with the many different avenues of communication. Many comments called for a centralized location for communication between the school, families, and PTO
- FAMILIES ARE VERY UPSET ABOUT THE MISALIGNMENT OF THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY CALENDARS, AS WELL AS LATE START BEING A
 HINDERANCE ON WORKING FAMILIES
- LASTLY, VOLUNTEERING CAME UP QUITE A BIT REGARDING LACK OF OPPORTUNITIES POST-COVID AND SIGN-UPS BEING CONTINUALLY FULL

INNOVATIVE ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT

- ACADEMICS WERE MENTIONED REGARDING STUDENTS ON ADVANCED LEARNING PLANS, AS WELL AS CONCERNS OVER LEARNING GAPS DUE TO COVID
 NOT BEING ADDRESSED
- 4TH GRADE HOMEWORK WAS A CONCERN IN A LARGE AMOUNT OF COMMENTS. MANY RESPONDENTS BELIEVED THERE IS TOO MUCH HOMEWORK AND THAT STUDENTS HAVE NO TIME TO JUST BE KIDS

MULTIPLE PATHWAYS TO SUCCESS

• REQUESTS FOR MORE **EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**, AS WELL AS EXTENDED JAG CARE.

CHARACTER AND VALUES

• A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF COMMENTS MENTIONED <u>SAFETY CONCERNS</u> AND CONCERNS ABOUT <u>DISCIPLINARY PRACTICES</u>. THESE RANGED FROM DRIVE-LINE PROCEDURES TO DISSATISFACTION WITH HOW BULLYING AND DISCIPLINE ARE ADDRESSED.

SAC RECOMMENDATIONS & NEXT STEPS

1. COMMUNICATION

- CENTRALIZED LOCATION FOR ALL COMMUNICATION AND MAINTAIN A HISTORY
 - FACEBOOK SHOULD NOT BE A PRIMARY COMMUNICATION PATHWAY; MANY FAMILIES DO NOT HAVE A FACEBOOK ACCOUNT
 - Pto communication and volunteering opportunities should be more equitable to entire JA community
- VISIBILITY ONLINE OF STUDENT ASSIGNMENTS/SPECIAL PROJECTS

2. SCHEDULE

- ALIGN ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL CALENDAR
- Late Start + PD days
 - Possibly offer care for families before school
 - COMMUNICATE THE WHY FOR LATE START AND NET BENEFITS WHILE SEEKING SOLUTIONS FOR FAMILIES.

3. INDIVIDUAL LEARNING NEEDS

- KEEP ADVANCED LEARNERS ENGAGED AND MAKE SURE ALP GOALS ARE BEING MET
- Recognize student achievements and positive character traits thru awards
- ACTION PLAN FOR ADDRESSING LEARNING GAPS DUE TO COVID E.G. TUTORING OR THROUGH MTSS PROCESS
- OFFER EXTRACURRICULAR LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES AFTER SCHOOL
- REEVALUATE THE AMOUNT OF HOMEWORK GIVEN TO STUDENTS
