- SOME RESPONDENTS FEELING THAT THE ACADEMIC RIGOR AT JA HAS DECLINED.
- A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF RESPONSES MENTIONED CONCERNS OVER TOO MUCH HOMEWORK.
- A LARGE GROUP OF COMMENTS MENTIONED DROP-OFF/PICKUP RELATED ISSUES.

## COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNICATIONS

$\because$ A NEED FOR IMPROVED COMMUNICATION, THOUGH MORE TIMELY AND CLEAR MESSAGING, PARTICULARLY AROUND ELECTIVES AND CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT COURSES; CURRENT AND ACCURATE SYLLABUS AND CALENDARS AVAILABLE.

## INNOVATIVE ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT

- IMPROVED ORIENTATION FOR TRANSITION FROM ELEMENTARY TO SECONDARY CAMPUSES, AS WELL AS CLEAR AND CONSISTENT MESSAGING AROUND JUNIOR HIGH GPA IMPORTANCE.
- REQUESTS FOR AN EXPANDED SELECTION OF LANGUAGES, MUSIC, AND ART OPTIONS.
- A NUMBER OF RESPONDENTS CONCERNED WITH MATH FACULTY, FEELING THAT STUDENTS ARE FALLING BEHIND.
- A LARGE NUMBER OF RESPONDENTS EXPRESSED CONCERN OVER THE LITERATURE CURRICULUM AND WOULD LIKE MORE TRANSPARENCY AND PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT.
- A NUMBER OF PARENTS CALLING FOR MORE INTERACTIVE LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES BETWEEN TEACHERS AND STUDENTS, AND LESS (OR NO) CELL-PHONE TIME.
