








PERCENTAGE OF PARENTS THAT ATTENDED PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES.




WHAT WAS YOUR OVERALL SATISFACTION WITH PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES?




DOES YOUR CHILD(REN) FEEL SAFE AT JEFFERSON ACADEMY SECONDARY?






HAS YOUR CHILD EXPERIENCED ANY UNSAFE SITUATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS?













HOW DO YOU PREFER TO RECEIVE UPDATES FROM JEFFERSON ACADEMY SECONDARY?




WHAT PREVENTS FAMILIES FROM COMPLETING THE REQUIRED 20 VOLUNTEER HOURS?




Do you feel your student(s) have academic gaps that are lingering as a result of the pandemic disruption?

Do you have the support you need to address the academic gaps of your student(s)?







FEEDBACK IMPACTING STRATEGIC GOALS

COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNICATIONS

- BETTER COMMUNICATION WITH TEACHERS, MORE SUPPORT FOR STRUGGLING STUDENTS, MORE ENGAGED TEACHERS/TEACHERS CARE MORE ABOUT STUDENTS & THEIR SUCCESS
- CALENDARS: LESS DAYS OFF, NO LATE STARTS (OR COMBINE INTO FULL DAYS OFF), ALLOW KIDS INTO BUILDING EARLY ON LATE
 STARTS, RELEASE CALENDARS EARLIER, FIX WEB SITE/GOOGLE CALENDARS (NOT HELPFUL CURRENTLY)
- LATE START + PD DAYS SEEMS CONFUSING AND DUPLICATIVE
- CELL PHONE POLICY APPLIED TO HIGH SCHOOL TOO, MORE CONSISTENT

INNOVATIVE ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT

- More structure for Back-to-School night (especially for incoming/new students) or orientation
- CLASS OFFERINGS: MORE BUSINESS ELECTIVES, SPANISH HIGHER THAN 3, 8TH GRADE ALGEBRA OFFERED AS HS SEMESTER
 INSTEAD OF YEAR LONG BUT ALSO REQUESTS FOR ALL GRADES YEAR-ROUND MATH, MORE INSTRUCTOR-LED LANGUAGE CLASSES,
 MORE INSTRUCTOR-LED COMPUTER SCIENCE CLASSES, MORE STEM CLASSES
- More sports offered, girl teams of existing boy sports, busses for athletic events, less control of students spectators at games (ex. Not allowing them to cheer)
- BUILDING SECURITY: OFFICE DOOR NOT LOCKED, NO ONE IN OFFICE AT TIMES

Multiple Pathways to Success

- High School concurrent college offerings more beyond FRCC such as CU, certain courses/credits from Warren Tech, etc. more AP classes
- ACADEMIC RIGOR BOTH TOO MUCH/NOT ENOUGH, CONCERN ON STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT A OR B FALLING BEHIND, LESS HOMEWORK AS BUSYWORK/ALLOW MORE TIME FOR CLUBS AND SPORTS/BETTER MENTAL HEALTH AND LESS STRESS ON STUDENTS, HOMEWORK CLUB OR UPPERCLASSMAN TUTORING (ALREADY EXISTS BUT MAY NEED MORE PROMOTION)

- BETTER COMMUNICATION WITH TEACHERS, MORE SUPPORT FOR STRUGGLING STUDENTS, MORE ENGAGED TEACHERS/TEACHERS CARE MORE ABOUT STUDENTS & THEIR SUCCESS
- VISIBILITY ONLINE OF STUDENT ASSIGNMENTS/SPECIAL PROJECTS
- IMPROVE ORIENTATION FOR INCOMING/NEW SECONDARY STUDENTS

2. SCHEDULE

- ALIGN ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL CALENDAR
- LATE START + PD DAYS
 - Communicate the WHY for Late Start and Net Benefits while seeking solutions for families

3. ACADEMICS

- ACADEMIC RIGOR: HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS
- College/Trade School tracks, more AP class offerings
- ADDRESS OPTIONS FOR MORE ELECTIVES AND EXTRACURRICULARS.
